## Script

### NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

I regret to inform you that we have reason to believe that our website has been the victim of a hacking incident. As such, your name, address, telephone number, email address and credit card information may have been accessed.

We take this very seriously and are thoroughly investigating this incident and we are taking appropriate action to prevent it from happening again. We have already done the following: we have temporarily disabled the taking of credit card information on our website, we have significantly edited our website code, we are changing our web hosting service, and we are planning to work with a data security consultant.

It is possible that some of your personal data was compromised. Luckily, there are some things which you can do to protect yourself against fraudulent misuse of your information.

1. You can notify your credit card provider about this incident and watch for any unusual activity on your credit card accounts or suspicious items on your bills.
2. In order to prevent anyone from opening new accounts in your name, contact the three major credit card bureaus and ask that a "fraud alert" be placed on your file.
3. Would you like the fraud reporting telephone numbers for the three major credit bureaus? 1-800-525-6285 (Equifax); 1-888-EXPERIAN (Experian); and 1-800-680-7289 (Trans Union). The fraud alert notation will tell the credit bureau not to extend new credit without first obtaining your consent.
4. The telephone numbers for ordering credit reports are: 1-800-685-1111 (Equifax); 1-888-397-3742 (Experian); and 1-800-916-8800 (Trans Union). The credit bureaus will also send you, annually, a free credit report. To obtain this report you can call 1-877-322-8228.
5. If you find that any of your accounts have been fraudulently opened, accessed, or used, you should notify the police, and the creditors or financial institutions concerned, as soon as possible.
