On June 20, 2006, a Bank employee inadvertently e-mailed a document containing customer names and credit card account numbers of six New York residents to a non-Bank employee at another financial institution. An internal review of the incident determined it was unintentional. Within less than one hour, the person who received the e-mail notified the Bank employee of the error, and we confirmed that the e-mail had been deleted by the recipient. Additional procedures are being implemented to prevent possible recurrences.
