Re: TIRES ACROSS AMERICA'S STATUS REPORT

The alliance of Tires Across America is providing documentation regarding the total number of warranty claims that NHTSA may or may not be aware of; the importance of the Firestone Steeltex class action to the company's financial standing by its appearance in the 2004 Bridgestone Annual Report and certain information regarding the individual state's Attorneys General cooperation regarding the number of claims they are aware of within their individual states.

The guilty verdicts rendered this week in the Enron case will send a message to Bridgestone Firestone that any misrepresentations made by it about the condition of its tires will not be tolerated. The following list of documents is just a sample of the evidence against Bridgestone Firestone regarding the numerous misrepresentations made about its tires.

1. Sales contracts from several states including Michigan and North Carolina for purchase of Firestone Steeltex truck, SUV and ambulance tires;
2. 3 sample letters from U.S. State Attorneys General's offices providing claim information regarding the Firestone Steeltex Class Action;
3. Excerpts from Bridgestone Corporation's 2004 annual report regarding the Firestone Steeltex Class Action;
4. A reference to the U.S. District court opinion regarding NHTSA reports being inadmissible in federal court because they are "untrustworthy";
5. Copies of two Inspector General's releases regarding NHTSA "underperforming under the early warning system" and is "over-budget";
6. A copy of the cover of Bridgestone Passenger Radial Cured Tire Guide, used to specially handle "abnormal conditions" "causes" and "countermeasures";
7. A copy of the Ohio Ambulance Licensing Board News, September, 2003, wherein Bridgestone Firestone has lied regarding the condition of the ambulance tires.
