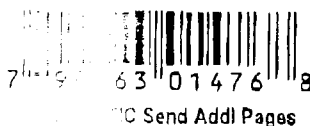
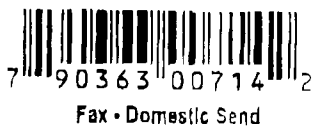

Computer Stolen from Denver Office. Investigation Underway

Denver -- Affiliated Computer Services (ACS), who operates Colorado's Family Support Registry (FSR), announced today that a personal computer was stolen from a secured area of a local Denver office. ACS operates this program under contract to the Colorado Department of Human Services. The stolen computer contained family mandated program and personal information. An investigation was immediately launched, information gathered and law enforcement activities are ongoing.

A complete review has been conducted to identify the information contained on the computer, disable access, employ additional security precautions, and identify all individuals whose personal information resided on the computer. Activities to identify affected persons are underway. At present, there is no indication that any identity has been compromised or that the computer was stolen for that purpose.

The Colorado Bureau of Investigation is working with the Denver Police Department in conducting the theft and that investigation continues.

The computer was housed in a secured area with limited access and was password protected. The building where the computer was kept is also equipped with security and surveillance cameras which assisted the investigation. All parties will continue to monitor the situation closely and work with authorities to resolve the matter.
