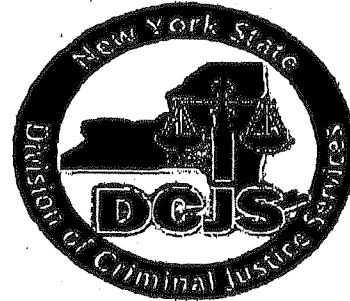



I am writing to you because of a recent security breach at the Division of Criminal Justice Services (Division) involving unauthorized access to your criminal history record.

The preliminary information obtained to date indicates that on January 29, 2007 and on February 2, 2007, a Division employee obtained unauthorized access to your criminal history record information, also referred to as a "rapsheet", containing your SSN and other personal information including your name, home address, date of birth, and your New York State and FBI identification numbers. Based upon the information we have obtained to date, it appears that there was a single disclosure outside the Division of the nature of your criminal history as a result of this security breach.

Please be advised that we are in the process of conducting a thorough investigation and appropriate measures will be taken to address this incident once all the facts have been determined. In addition, the Division is reviewing its current policies and procedures regarding access to such records to assure that no such breaches occur in the future.
