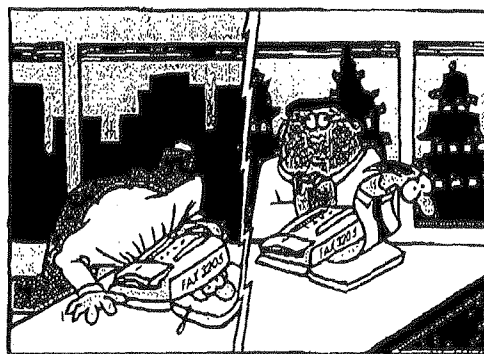

On 3/19/07, Investigator Tim Ortwein from the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office in Leesburg, Virginia called Ulster-Greene ARC, and informed Mark Vanyo that in the course of an identity theft investigation he had acquired a list of names together with personal information. Inv. Ortwein reported contacting one of the persons on the list who stated they worked or had worked at UGARC. Inv. Ortwein provided the list to Mr. Vanyo who confirmed all the individuals on the list either were current or former employees. Preliminary internal research suggests that the breach may have occurred as a result of a routine electronic transmission of employee information in July of 2002 between UGARC and its insurance broker, Marsh Mercer. However, this is not conclusive.
