

Dear Attorney General McDonnell:

As the Chief Privacy Official of State Farm, I am providing you this notice of our communication to one of your state residents. This communication is done pursuant to the Code of Virginia, Section 18.2-186.6. Only one resident from the state of Virginia will receive a notice regarding this incident, and it will be mailed December 16, 2008.

A State Farm Agent in Minnesota employed an individual who established credit cards in the names of several Minnesota customers. This agent's employee has been terminated and law enforcement authorities have been notified of the incident. Although there is no evidence the former employee used information from other customers of this agent in an unauthorized manner, we are unable to eliminate this possibility. Therefore, notice of the incident will be communicated to all customers of this Minnesota agent. The Virginia resident, and all customers notified, will receive an offer of one year of free credit monitoring.
