Re: Legal Notice of Potential Information Security Breach Pursuant to Mass. Genl. Laws Ch. 3H

To Whom It May Concern:

Stock & Option Solutions, Inc., a vendor of THQ, Inc., provides consulting services to THQ employees with regard to Employee Stock Purchase Plans. As you are aware, Massachusetts state law requires notice to the Massachusetts Attorney General in the event of an information security breach involving the personal information of Massachusetts residents. In accordance with that requirement, we write to inform you of an information security breach that occurred on March 1, 2008, later determined to concern personal data of THQ employees, both current and former, that it maintained.

On that date, a Stock & Option Solutions laptop computer, containing certain confidential information about THQ employees, was stolen from the possession of one of Stock & Option Solutions employees while traveling. The laptop, while not encrypted, was password protected. We have no information indicating the personal data has been accessed or that the stolen laptop was reported to the San Francisco Police Department. The police department's phone number is 080-222-3333. A redacted copy is enclosed.

We determined that approximately 100 Massachusetts residents related to THQ were affected by this incident. Pursuant to state law, we are in the process of notifying all affected individuals of the possible information security breach via written letter to each affected individual through first class mail, postage paid, which began March 25, 2008. For your convenience, a copy of the notice being sent to the affected individuals is enclosed with this letter.

The notice describes (1) the general nature of the incident resulting in the potential information security breach, (2) the type of personal information that was the subject of the possible security breach, (3) the precautionary measures Stock & Option Solutions is taking to help protect personal information from further unauthorized access, (4) contact information for inquiries

regarding the incident, (5) how to enroll in Kroll's ID TheftSmart™ service, which Stock & Option Solutions is making available to affected individuals free of charge for one year; (6) advice to individuals that they should also consider placing an initial fraud alert on their credit files and that they review account statements and monitor free credit reports that are available to them; (7) their right to obtain a police report; (8) how to request a security freeze; (9) the necessary information they will need to provide when requesting a security freeze; and (10) any fees required to be paid to any of the consumer reporting agencies.

We are writing to inform you, as THQ's vendor for employee stock options consulting, that your personal information may have been compromised as a result of a security breach on March 1, 2008 involving a stolen laptop. Personal information, such as your name, Social Security number and address, may have been exposed.

Upon discovery, the theft was immediately reported to the local police. So far, the laptop has not been recovered. Although we do not have any evidence that your information has been improperly accessed or misused, we want to assure you that we have taken the necessary steps to help safeguard against any damage that may result from this incident.

Because protecting your personal information is important to us, we have engaged Kroll Inc., the world's leading risk consulting company, to provide you with access, for one year, to its ID TheftSmart™ service. This service includes Continuous Credit Monitoring, as well as Enhanced Identity Theft Restoration, at no cost to you. You will have access to licensed investigators to guide you through the process and should you become a victim of identity fraud, your investigator will help restore your identity to pre-theft status.

ID TheftSmart is one of the most comprehensive programs available to help protect your name and credit against identity theft. We urge you to take the time to read about the safeguards now available to you. To take full advantage of the credit monitoring service, please note that you must complete and return the attached authorization form.

To help you guard yourself against identity theft or other unauthorized use of personal information about you, we recommend that you remain vigilant over the next 12 months and review your credit reports and your credit reports for unauthorized activity. Promptly report incidents of suspected identity theft to your local law enforcement agency, the Federal Trade Commission, your financial institution, and to one of the three national consumer reporting agencies listed below. You have the right to obtain a police report if you are a victim of identity theft. You may wish to contact your credit card issuers and financial institution and inform them of the incident.

In addition, you may contact the fraud departments of the three national consumer reporting agencies to discuss your options. Under Massachusetts law, you have the right to place a security freeze on your consumer report. A security freeze is designed to prevent credit, loans, and services from being approved in your name without your consent; however, using a security freeze may delay your ability to obtain credit. You may request that a security freeze be placed on your consumer report by sending a request to a consumer reporting agency by certified mail, overnight mail or regular stamped mail to the address below. The following information should be included when requesting a security freeze (documents from both the spouse and the victim must be submitted when requesting the spouse's consumer report): full name (including middle initial and any suffixes); Social Security number; date of birth (month, day and year); current address and previous addresses for the past two years; and applicable fee (if any) or incident report or complaint with law enforcement agency or the Registry of Motor Vehicles. also should include a copy of a government issued identification card, such as a driver's license, state or military ID card, and a copy of a utility bill, bank or insurance statement. Each copy should be legible, display your name and current mailing address, and the date of issue (statement dates must be recent). The consumer reporting agency may charge a reasonable fee of up to \$5.00 to place a freeze or lift or remove a freeze, unless you are a victim of identity theft or the spouse of a victim of identity theft, and have submitted a valid police report relating to the identity theft to the consumer reporting agency.

On today's date at approx. 1359 hrs. I was at Pier 40 near my police patrol vehicle when a citizen, (V1) [REDACTED] and (V2) [REDACTED] walked up to me with their small child and told me the car they had rented from (V3) Thrifty Rent a Car had its back window smashed out.

(V1) [REDACTED] and (V2) [REDACTED] they were told by their son that their back window had been smashed out. [REDACTED] immediately pulled his car over on seeing my above patrol car and flagged me down.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] told me they had locked and parked their (B) Rent a Car inside at 1000 hrs at the Public Parking Garage at 2000 Embarcadero North (cross of North Point) across the street from Pier 39.

[REDACTED] along with their son came back to the vehicle at 1230 hrs. [REDACTED] said that when they pulled over once they all realized the back (B) car's (D) back window was smashed out.
