
Dear Ms. Coakley:

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 93H § 3, I am notifying you that forms (Statement of Benefit Charges - Form 1088) containing the personal information of some 50 individuals were inadvertently routed to wrong employers.

The Department is working with these employers to ensure that the information is properly destroyed and continues to address this matter to determine how this error occurred. The Department has notified the data subjects regarding the inadvertent disclosure of their personal information. The notice contained information regarding requesting security freezes with credit reporting agencies. The notice also contained the name and contact person for any questions.

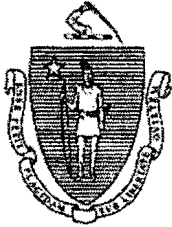

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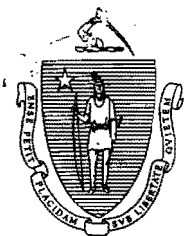
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
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
