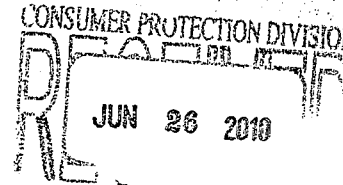

Dear Mr. Williams:

As the Chief Information Security and Privacy Official of State Farm, I am providing you this notice of our intended communication to three of your state residents. Three residents from the state of Maryland will receive a notice regarding this incident, and it will be mailed next week.

A State Farm Agent in Florida employed an individual who allegedly sold lists of customer information to a third party. This agent's employee has been terminated. Law enforcement has been involved in this incident, an arrest has been made, and an investigation is ongoing. Due to a law enforcement request, this letter is our earliest opportunity to notify customers about this incident.

We have been unable to confirm the extent of which customers were included in the information this person allegedly sold. As a precautionary measure, in addition to all of the agent's current customers, we are notifying all of her past customers as well as any prospective customers for whom we may have information. All customers notified will receive an offer of one year of free credit monitoring service. Contact information is being provided for the consumer reporting agencies and the Federal Trade Commission as well as information regarding free credit reports and fraud alerts.
