**Re: Misuse of Customer Credit Card---Notice of Potential Security Breach**

Dear Sir or Madam:


Pursuant to Maryland state law (H.B. 208 and S.B. 194) T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") is providing your office with this notice concerning a potential information security breach.

Pursuant to an internal investigation, T-Mobile uncovered the unauthorized use of 22 customer credit cards by a T-Mobile employee within a call center. The employee copied the credit card number given to him within the scope of his employment by the customer and used the number for his own gain. No computer systems were breached in the course of this misuse. This employee has been separated from employment. One Maryland state resident was financially impacted by this wrongdoer, and T-Mobile has remedied his harm.

Due to the nature of the unauthorized charges placed on the customer's account, we notified the customer immediately by telephone and will follow-up by mail.
