RE: Security breach involving theft of a laptop computer

Dear Attorney General Gansler:

Pursuant to The Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA), MD Stat. Ann. § 14-3504 we are writing to notify you of the unauthorized acquisition of personal information involving 208 Maryland residents. We are in the process of notifying all affected individuals according to PIPA guidelines.

On Monday, June 7, 2010, a laptop computer was stolen from the locked trunk of an employee's vehicle. The trunk was unlocked from inside the vehicle after the windows were smashed to gain access. The stolen laptop contained certain information concerning our clients including name, address, social security number, date of birth, and DJS number, and encounter information.

A police report was filed and at this point we have no specific knowledge that the information contained on the laptop has been accessed. The investigation is ongoing. We are reviewing our policies and employee training program to reduce the risk of future unauthorized disclosure. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any further questions regarding the incident or the ongoing investigation.
